

SUNRAIL STATION

SUNRAIL is a train system that currently connects 12 stations from North to South, and from 2018 will add 4 stations to the South, including Kissimmee and Ponciana.

SUNRAIL Station located near the intersection of Orange Avenue and SandLake Road, serves an expanding residential and business district in south-central Orlando. The station also offers bus connections to all areas of attractions, as well as to Orlando International Airport. This station also serves residents of nearby counties and includes a large parking lot for service users.

ORLANDO INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

ORLANDO'S AVIATION AUTHORITY HAS COMPLETED AN IMPROVEMENT PLAN FOR ITS AIRPORT FOR \$1.1 BILLION.

With a capacity of 45 million flyers annually. The new South Terminal, will stimulate the general economy of central Florida.

The new connector will not only improve the infrastructure of the region's transportation, but will also provide ease to the growing number of travelers. The extension of the travel system of passengers towards the South, construction of a new transportation system/garage and new travel installations to accommodate train passengers.

Improvements to customs areas and border patrol to the U.S. as well as upgrades to ticket receptions in the North terminal and baggage system.



THE BRIGHTLINE

THE \$2.5 BILLION PRIVATELY FUNDED PROJECT WILL HAVE TRAINS TRAVELING UP TO 125 MILES PER HOUR BETWEEN MIAMI, FORT LAUDERDALE, WEST PALM BEACH AND ORLANDO. THE THREE SO UTI I FLORIDA STATIONS ARE CURRENTLY UNDER CONSTRUCTION, AND RAIL TRACK IMPROVEMENTS ARE UNDERWAY.

The Miami-Fort Lauderdale-West Palm Beach service is expected to start in mid-2017, with the connection to Orlando opening in late 2017. The Brightline is promising trips of less than 30 minutes from Miami to Fort Lauderdale, under 60 minutes from Miami to West Palm Beach, and about three hours from Miami to Orlando.
